

REMOTE LEARNING ABSENCE RULE

Attendance/Participation in Remote Learning

- Absent when not participating in planned instructional activities on remote learning day
- Synchronous or asynchronous
- Participation in scheduled activities on a remote learning day includes, not limited to:
 - Daily logins to learning management systems;
 - Daily interactions with teacher(s) to acknowledge attendance (including messages, emails, phone calls or video chats); or
 - Evidence of participation in a task or assignment



EXCUSED ABSENCES DUE TO COVID-19

Additional Reasons for Excused Absences related to COVID

Absences related to or due to:

- the student's illness, health condition, or medical appointments due to COVID-19;
- caring for a family member who has an illness, health condition, or medical appointment due to COVID-19;
- the student's employment or other family obligations during regularly scheduled school hours that are temporarily necessary due to COVID-19
- the student's parent's work schedule or other obligations during regularly scheduled school hours
- the student's lack of necessary instructional tools, including internet broadband access or connectivity
- other COVID-19 related circumstances
